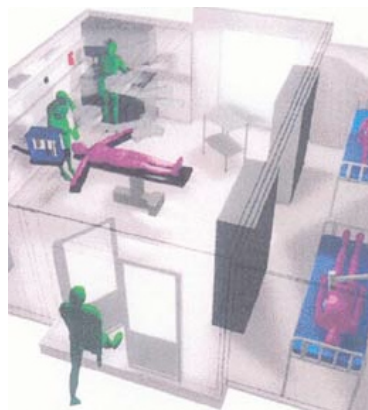
Experience following Earthquakes



Emergency and mobile hospitals are available for use following disasters across the world and can be set up within hours of an incident anywhere.

These systems have been used specifically with earthquake response. Following the 2001 earthquake in Gujarat, India, a hospital center was constructed within hours of the incident. This hospital treated approximately 100-130 people per day from its first establishment. In 2005, these mobile hospitals were delivered following a heavy earthquake in Pakistan. This hospital included an operating room, ICU, doctors' office, pharmacy, laboratory, blood bank, shower and toilets. The delivery included a generator, heating and cooling plants, and water purifying system.
